Call for papers and participants

The PRME Chapter Poland is very happy to launch the first World Tour Research Paper Development Program (WTRP Development Program). This workshop is co-organised in partnership with PRME Secretariat, PRME World Tour Organizing Committee, Department for International Political Economy (ZMPE) SGH and leading international journals in the responsible management, sustainable development and business-in-society fields: *Business & Society*, *Journal of Business Ethics* and *Economics and Environment (Ekonomia i Środowisko)*. The event is also supported by eminent publishers of professional and academic books and journals among others Routledge and Springer.

WTRP Development Program “Polish edition” is held under the title: “The broad question of sustainability: corporate, social and public policies perspectives”.

To participate in this innovative workshop, please consider submitting your best research to this **call for papers and participants**.

The workshop will take place 22nd June 2023. It will be chaired by Prof. Anna Visvizi, Chair of International Political Economy, SGH Warsaw School of Economics, Prof. Giuseppe T. Cirella University of Gdansk and Polo Centre of Sustainability and Prof. Scott Taylor, Chair of Leadership & Organization Studies, Birmingham Business School, University of Birmingham, UK, and Development Editor, *Journal of Business Ethics* and Prof. Agnieszka Domańska, ZMPE, Chair of PRME Polish Chapter.

Research and publishing mentors will include representatives from each of these journals and others in the field, such as *Business Ethics: A European Review* and *Business Ethics Quarterly*.

The deadline for submissions is 28th February 2023. Please submit it to the following e-mail address: polandWTRP@sgh.waw.pl

Your submission can be in one of three categories:

- a) paper in development;
- b) paper ready for submission;
- c) paper already reviewed unsuccessfully.

Papers must be between 3,000 and 10,000 words total length.

We invite papers both in English and Polish. There will be mentoring groups for texts written in those two languages.

Description of the WTRP project

The WTRP supports both early-career and more experienced scholars in bringing research to publication, as part of PRME's commitment to relevant and timely research insights that advance responsible management and sustainable development around the world. Successful workshops in South America, North America, Europe, India, and South Asia already mean that more than a hundred research papers have been developed towards publication, for researchers at all career stages, in all management and business disciplines focused on responsible management research or education.

The PRME World Tour also has a more general ambition of supporting the professionalization of the scholarly field of responsible management research, by increasing the range of voices heard as authors and representing concerns too often marginalised or excluded from the most prestigious journals. This call is part of the second year of this initiative.

WORKSHOP AGENDA

The workshop will have two parts, as follows:

ONE:

The first part is open to anyone interested in participating.

- **Editors panel:** Editors discuss how to publish responsible management and sustainable business research in international, peer-reviewed management journals. The panel will feature current and former editors and associate editors from general management journals such as the Academy of Management journals, *Human Relations*, *Organization Studies*, *Management Learning*, *Organization*, Digital Policy, Regulation

and Governance (DPRG), as well as specialized responsible management journals such as *Business Ethics Quarterly*, *Business & Society*, *Journal of Business Ethics* and *Economics and Environment*.

- **Keynote:** A senior scholar speaks of opportunities and challenges in researching and publishing in responsible management.
- **Q&A/Networking Breakout:** Participants have an opportunity to ask questions to panel members, in small group discussion in break-out rooms.

TWO:

The second part of the workshop is only open to authors who have submitted a paper that has been accepted by the organizing committee. This part is built around small group discussions where authors receive direct detailed feedback on their work in progress from mentors, all experienced scholars, editors, associate editors, board members, authors, and reviewers for leading management journals. Each paper will be read by two mentors, including at least one international scholar as well as invited scholars working at Polish universities or scholars with a research connection to Poland.

Please indicate in your submission your target journal or journals. We welcome the submission of both empirical papers (quantitative, qualitative, or mixed methods) and theoretical or review work. Please include a cover page with authors' identification (names, institutions, ORCID if possible).

Paper topics must be in the broad field of responsible management and sustainable development. Priority will be given to papers that:

- are high quality works in progress;
- have potential for publication in influential journals;
- are focused on topics related to the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs);
- increase the range of voices heard in the field.

We may give preference to researchers currently working in a Polish Higher Education Institution or researchers cooperating with representatives from a Polish HEI under e.g. academic exchange programmes. However the call is open from any students or scholars interested in sustainability and responsible business issues working in Central Europe.

Participants must be able to communicate in English and must be available for full commitment to the event on the scheduled day.

Deadline for submission: February 28th, 2023. Please submit your work in progress to (mail contact to be filled) with the message title "PRME World Tour Research Paper Development Poland". Decisions will be communicated by April 12th, 2023
