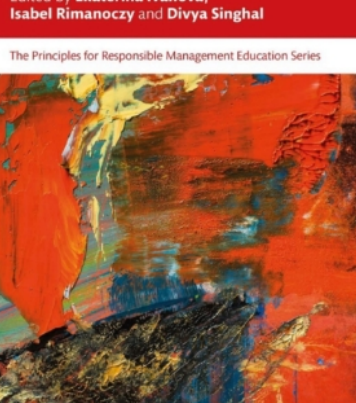

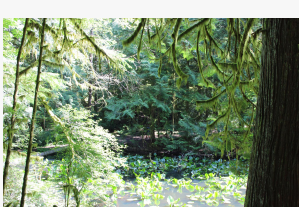


The UN Global Compact has a number of available internship opportunities for its various teams in 2026.
