**PRME & Routledge Call for Expressions of Interest: Book Chapter Contributions**

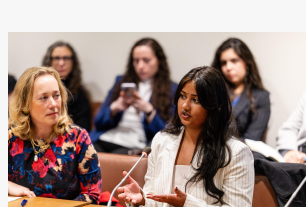
